ABOUT WALTER SISULU UNIVERSITY

Walter Sisulu University (WSU) was established on 1 July, 2005 (by a three-way merger) in terms of the Higher Education Act No. 101 of 1997, as amended. The new university was named in honour of an icon of the South African liberation struggle, the late Walter Max Ulyate Sisulu who was a close comrade of Nelson Mandela.

As one of six comprehensive universities in South Africa, WSU has positioned itself as a developmental university focusing on **urban renewal and rural development**. It may be characterised as **scientific, technological, innovative and responsive** to local community needs, the requirements of commerce and industry and the socio-economic niche areas of national government.

WSU is uniquely positioned to play a powerful role in the national government's new focus on rural development in particular. 29,500 students and about 2,500 staff live and work across four campuses with thirteen delivery sites:

Mthatha Campus: Nelson Mandela Drive, Zamukulungisa and Nkululekweni Sites

Butterworth Campus: Ibika Site and Vuli Valley Site

Buffalo City Campus: (East London): Potsdam, Chiselhurst, College Street, Heritage Building, Cambridge Street and Buffalo City Stadium Sites

ABSTRACT

This study focused on determinants of risky sexual behaviours among undergraduate students of Walter Sisulu University. The aim was to describe the determinants of risky sexual behaviour among undergraduate students in order to strengthen existing intervention strategies. Mixed method research and concurrent triangulation design were used. The study was conducted at all four WSU campuses in the Eastern Cape Province. Self-administered questionnaires were administered to 1024 students and four focus group interviews were conducted with 27 participants. The data were analyzed using SPSS version 20 software package and N'VIVO 10 computer package.

The results of the quantitative research designs were that 93.95% of sexually active respondents had practiced risky sexual behaviours. 91.6% of students were heterosexual, 5.86% homosexual and 2.54% bisexual. Unprotected sex was reported by 39.75% of the research sample while 38.38% had sexual intercourse with a stranger; 10.86% had their last sexual intercourse alcohol-induced; 55% of homosexuals had unprotected sex while unprotected sex figures for heterosexuals and bisexuals were 39% and 30.80% respectively. However, 40.23%, ($p = 0.001$) of respondents had intention to abstain from sex in the next 12 months, whilst the majority 77.83%, ($p = 0.30$) had intention to be faithful to one sexual partner, and 74.22%, ($p = 0.766$) had intention to use condom. The intention not to have sex with someone older was 56.45%, ($p < 0.01$) and intention not to have sex in exchange for money or goods was 68.85%, ($p = 0.009$). The results of qualitative research design findings were almost similar to the

quantitative design except that participants felt they had freedom from parental control, peer pressure, and male domination.

The recommended intervention strategy are creation of platforms for students to debate and have support groups in order to improve some of the challenges students face. WSU management should devise strategies of raising funds for the needy students in order to minimize sex work and sexual intercourse with older partners. Collaboration between WSU Student Development and Support services and academic faculties is recommended to make sexual reproductive health/life skills part of the curriculum for all students.

The study examined early childhood exposure to marijuana cultivation and trading and its influence on adolescents’ marijuana use in two selected Pondoland communities of South Africa. The research area was crucial given the high prevalence of marijuana use among adolescents in South Africa. Two-case qualitative case study techniques, pinned on constructivists’ philosophical assumptions, were used to gather the required data for the study. The target participants were all adolescents and adults who had been involved in marijuana related activities as children in two purposefully selected communities in the Ingquza Hill Local Municipality of the Pondoland region. The total number of participants was fifty-two, selected through snowball sampling technique. The sample comprised of marijuana smokers, non-marijuana smokers, key informants and gatekeepers. The main research instruments used for this study included face-to-face semi-structured interviews and observation schedule. Thematic content analysis approach was used to analyse the data, guided by the research question. The study established that children are deeply involved in marijuana production for a number of socio-ecological reasons such as orphanage, protection of family land from encroachers. Children are often directly and deliberately involved in marijuana production with no consideration for age, so long as a child has the ability to perform an assigned task. Furthermore, while the communities do not condone child marijuana smoking, children’s involvement in marijuana cultivation or trading seems not to be a concern of many residents as the practice is seen as an income provision venture. Based on the findings, community-specific socio-ecological intervention model has been designed for consideration by stakeholders to help shield children from being involved in marijuana cultivation or trading, leading to their use of the drug.

ABSTRACT

Reproductive health implies that people are able to have a responsible, satisfying and safe sex life with the ability to reproduce and the freedom to decide if, when and how often to do so (WHO, 2011:1). However, some pregnancies are not planned. Once a pregnancy is unplanned anxiety, fear and emotional instability are some of the reactions that could lead to a choice of termination of pregnancy (CTOP). This is more likely to happen to vulnerable groups such as teenagers, unmarried women, divorcees or women who are separated from their partners, and women who feel they are not ready to raise a child. According to the South African Choice on Termination of Pregnancy Act (Act no. 92 of 1996) the termination of pregnancy can be performed by either a medical doctor or by a Professional Nurse who has undergone approved training or in-service education in this regard.

The AmaXhosa tribe took pride in promotion of sexual abstinence especially among young girls, to an extent that regular tests were carried out to determine whether they were still virgins. However, nowadays, pregnancy and CTOP are very common

amongst AmaXhosa women as they are vulnerable to pregnancy before marriage and exposing themselves CTOP risks. Thus, the purpose of this study was to explore the risk and vulnerability modalities of choice of termination of pregnancy amongst the rural and urban AmaXhosa women in the Eastern Cape Province, South Africa. The theoretical framework that guided this study is Leininger's Culture Care, Diversity and Universality Nursing Theory. This was a cross-sectional and correlational study that uses mixed methods and ethn nursing method. For the quantitative section, questionnaires were used to collect data from AmaXhosa women who had conducted CTOP, and for the qualitative section, four focus groups were used to collect data from professional nurses who had been trained in conducting CTOP. A total of 150 questionnaires were distributed but eighty were returned. Simple random sampling was used for the quantitative section and convenience sampling was used for the qualitative design. Quantitative data was analysed using SPSS and qualitative data was analyzed using Leininger's phases of Ethn nursing data analysis guide (2006: 61). Qualitative data was then arranged in graphs, tables, following major themes and care patterns.

The results from both quantitative and qualitative, revealed that AmaXhosa women as young as 12 years old sought CTOP. The culture of AmaXhosa was not considered by nurses when attending to them because their CTOP curriculum and Constitution of South Africa stipulate that there should be no discrimination by race, colour or creed. The legal age to carry out CTOP is 13 years and school-going girls were found to be accessing CTOP services. Premarital sex was influenced by peers and there was a problem of acculturation where AmaXhosa women were copying values from other cultures. It was also highlighted by general informants that young girls had love relationships with older men for financial gain.

The complications that were reported from CTOP were infection, severe hemorrhage, recurrent abortion, infertility, guilt which sometimes ended up in depression and mental illness. An increase in alcohol consumption by youth, peer pressure, and weak family structures, are some of the factors that led women to CTOP. In summary this study showed that there was cultural diffusion which has diluted AmaXhosa value system.

The recommendations were discussed using Leininger's Culture Care and Diversity and Universality theory. They were grouped according to the three modalities of nursing which are: culture care preservation and/or maintenance, culture care accommodation and/or negotiation and, cultural care restructuring and/or re-patterning.
