## ADMISSION OF STUDENTS WITH A SENIOR CERTIFICATE, NATIONAL CERTIFICATE (OR VOCATIONAL LEVEL 4)

In terms of the Government Gazette of 07 December 2018, WSU accepts applications from prospective students who have a National Certificate (Vocational-Level 4) and who wish to register for Higher Certificate, Diploma or Degree programmes.

## National Certificate (Vocational) NC(V)

Minimum requirements for admission to the higher Certificate, Diploma and Bachelor's Degree

## Higher Certificate

Subject to institutional admission requirements, the minimum admission requirements to a Higher Certificate programme are (a) a National Certificate (Vocational) Level 4 issued by the Council for General and Further Education and Training and (b) compliance with the requirements for the language of learning and teaching in the higher education institution.

## Diploma

Subject to institutional admission requirements, the minimum admission requirement is a National Certificate (Vocational) Level 4 issued by Council for General and Further Education and Training.

In addition, a student must (a) achieve at least $40 \%$ in three fundamental subjects, including the language of learning and teaching in the higher education institution, and (b) achieve at least $50 \%$ in the three compulsory vocational subjects.

## Bachelor's Degree

Subject to institutional admission requirements, the minimum admission requirement to a Bachelor's Degree programme is a National Certificate (Vocational) Level 4 issued by Council for General and Further Education and Training.

In addition, a student must (a) achieve $50 \%$ in three fundamental subjects, including the language of learning and teaching in the higher education institution, and (b) achieve at least $60 \%$ in four vocational subjects chosen from the NC (V) Level 4 Subjects.
